Pursuant to notice published in the Valley Voice, February 22, 2024 and attached to these minutes, the Cambridge Planning Commission met for regular meeting beginning at 6:00 P.M. Present were Planning Commission Chairman Jason Cobb and Planning Commission Members Barb Stoddard, Troy Westadt, Troy Westadt and Austin White. Staff present for the meeting was City Clerk/Treasurer Courtney Stanton.
