Site Plan and Land Use Applications:

Nebraska Corn Processing & Jason Cobb – 107 Potter – Fuel Storage Tank. Floodplain Development Permit Application was signed by Jason Cobb. Jason Weiss stated the motion, seconded by Debbi Runner, to approve the site plan and land use permit application of Nebraska Corn Processing and Jason Cobb, 107 Potter Street installation of 91,000 gallon fuel storage tank. <u>Douglas and Sandra Sweeney – 815 Dolan – removal of broken concrete</u>.
